- 1A* Potatoes -5, any variety**
- 2A* Onions - 3, any variety**
- 3A Runner Beans - 5, one variety**
- 4A Courgettes - 3, displayed with flower**
- 5A Tomatoes - 5, cherry variety**
- 6A Tomatoes - 3, any variety**
- 7A Cucumber -1, any variety**
- 8A Soft Fruit - any variety, displayed in own dish**
- 9A* Apples - 3, eating variety**
- 10A Herbs (named & cut) - 5, culinary herbs displayed in small containers**

SECTION “B” - FLOWERS

- 1B Rose - 1 bloom, any variety**
- 2B Gladioli - 1 spike**
- 3B Dahlia -3 blooms same variety**
- 4B Dahlia - 3 blooms mixed variety**
- 5B Sweet Peas - 5 stems, single or mixed variety**
- 6B Mixed Flowers -1 vase excluding items above**
- 7B Flower heads displayed in water container max. 9” diameter**
- 8B Single stem flower - not already in the schedule**
- 9B Pot plant, flowering in container with a max. diameter of 7”**

SECTION “C” - Domestic

- 1C Jar of fruit jam**
- 2C Victoria sandwich cake – jam only, 8” max diameter**
- 3C* Cheese scones 3, any shape**
- 4C Shortbread biscuits 4, any shape**
- 5C Small loaf of bread 1, any grain**

SECTION “D” - Floral

- 1D Arrangement in a tea cup and saucer**
